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L. Action Item(s)

1. Intergovernmental Agreement for Funding

Member Beri, supported by Member Blackmon, moved that the Wayne RESA Board of Education authorize administration to execute an intergovernmental agreement, with the term of four years, with the Charter County of Wayne for the purposes of receiving financial assistance for the Future Aviation & Aeronautics Professionals Career & Technical Education (CTE) Program. The motion passed with a voice vote of 3-0.

2. Appointment of Executive Director, Early Childhood – Kelley Williams

Member Blackmon, supported by Member Beri, moved that the Wayne RESA Board of Education approve the appointment of Kelley Williams to the position of Executive Director of Early Childhood, effective July 21, 2026. The motion passed with a voice vote of 3-0.

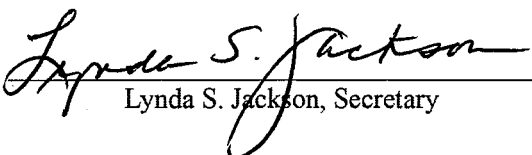
