Member Beri noted some of Wendolyn Anderson's qualifications including serving as a parent volunteer in the district.

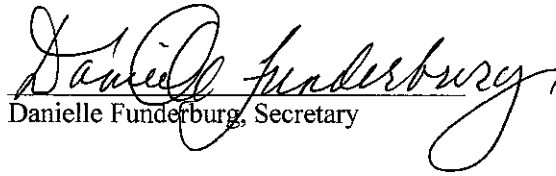
