F. Other Superintendent / Board Discussion Items

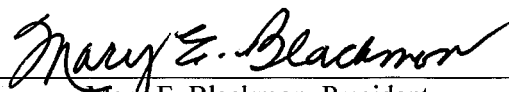
- Emergency contact information forms were distributed to Board members for completion.
