Michigan's Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health Consultation (also known as Social Emotional Consultation) is a prevention-based intervention teaming mental health professionals with early care and education providers and families from birth through age five.



How is Social Emotional Consultation Beneficial?

Our highly trained consultants provide specialized consultation and professional development that will help early care and education providers to:

- avoid expelling children from early care and learning settings
- address challenging behavior in positive ways
- provide learning environments that are equitable and free from bias while promoting children's development and resilience

Consultants also provide community outreach to promote the important of:

- Understanding children's behaviors and social emotional needs
- Accessing mental health services
- Creating quality, trauma focused, learning environments
- Self-care and Mindfulness
- Parent communication and engagement
