Questions and Answers

1. Is there a estimated number of students that will be served for purposes of this contract out of the 16,500(6%) targeted in Wayne County? Or is the goal to reach all 16,500 with this contract?
As this is a Request for Information (RFI), a contract will not be established through this project. Instead, the intent is to collect written information about the capabilities of various suppliers. Once the information is received, Wayne RESA may then choose to conduct a Request for Proposal (RFP), which may result in a contract. Should an RFP be conducted, the goal would be to target 11,500 of the 16,500 students.
2. What is the time frame of the contract?
As this is a Request for Information (RFI), a contract will not be established through this project. Instead, the intent is to collect written information about the capabilities of various suppliers. Once the information is received, Wayne RESA may choose to conduct a Request for Proposal (RFP), which may result in a contract. Should an RFP be conducted, the goal would be to have student identification and need assessment completed by September 30, 2021
